Who's involved in your apprenticeship?

School

Students in Year 10, 11 or 12 may be eligible to complete a school-based apprenticeship or traineeship, allowing them to gain employment-based training while continuing full-time school and working towards their Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE).

Department of Employment, Small Business and Training (DESBT)

The Department of Employment Small Business and Training (State Government) is responsible for overseeing apprenticeships and traineeships in Queensland and supports jobseekers and businesses through grants and training programs.

Employer

Thats you! An employer hires the apprentice and provides on-the-job training, practical work experience, and supports the apprentice's formal education with a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) to learn the skills of your trade.

Apprentice

An apprenticeship involves learning a trade from the employer, combining paid, onthe-job training with formal education.
